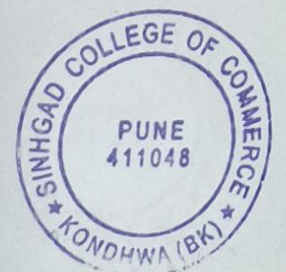

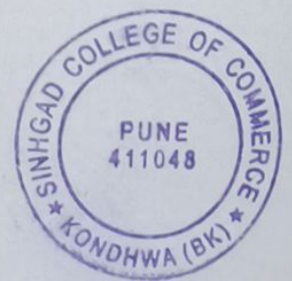

ABOUT COLLEGE

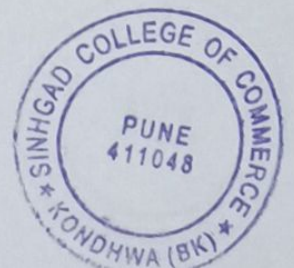
